

Modi cannot raise Bengal violence issue: Mamata

PM must reply to his own misdeeds: Bengal CM

Kolkata, Aug 13: West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Saturday came down heavily on the Prime Minister, stating before talking about violence in Bengal, he should answer what they are doing in Manipur for the past three months.

"He should answer why people in Tripura weren't allowed to contest on over 93 per cent of the seats during the panchayat polls. He should answer why 40 per cent of the seats in Uttar Pradesh were won by them uncontested. He should answer why Manipur's Dalits are not even getting water or basic necessities while he helps his leaders construct lavish buildings for their own residences," Banerjee charged.

"He should answer how much money he has gifted during his foreign tours. He must answer where did the PM CARES funds go. Crores were poured into it

through CSR. The bonus of Central Government employees was stopped and they even took a one-day pay cut for the same," she alleged.

"Under the garb of demonetisation, he banned currency notes and brought in new notes of 2000 denomination. Now, that too has been banned. In between, crores just vanish and people are left wondering. First, he should explain his own scandals. He is repeatedly visiting foreign countries, striking deals, giving gifts, and returning with certificates. Has he ever given details of these deals in Parliament? Earlier, PMs would brief Parliament after their foreign tours but he has given no speeches on External Affairs," Banerjee alleged.

Alleging that he cannot raise the corruption issue because he is fully surrounded by so many issues such as PM CARES Funds, Rafale Deal, the

agreement to sell defence factory, demonetisation, Banerjee said, "And now they have cancelled Rs. 2,000 note in their party's and their own interest. You can fool people some of the time but you cannot fool people all the time."

Banerjee asserted "Charity begins at home. They do not take action against their own people, who are corrupt, involved in character assassination, carrying out atrocities against women and wrestlers, or allowing violence in Manipur."

Instead of giving a message of humanity to the people, the Prime Minister chose to "malign" Bengal at a small event today, she further alleged and said, "I thank the PM's chair, not the individual, for remembering Bengal. He has insulted, deprived, oppressed, and caused pain to Bengal only to gratify BJP leaders here." As many as 54 Central

teams visited West Bengal seeking clarity based on the allegations levelled by local BJP leaders, she said adding, "We provided all such clarifications. Yet, no funds were allocated to West Bengal for the 2023-24 cycle. In fact, West Bengal is the only State that has not received any money."

The Chief Minister stated, "They have blocked the funds earmarked for poor people's homes in Bengal. More than 36 lakh people want homes under the scheme but the money was blocked by the Centre as per demands of local BJP leaders. They did not allocate a single rupee for the renovation of the rural roads which were damaged during monsoons."

The PM has deprived Bengal of its rights as the State is owed Rs. 1.15 lakh crore by him, she said adding she had met him five times on the matter.

Google tribute to Sridevi on 60th birth anniversary

Kolkata, Aug 13: Famed search engine Google on Sunday created a special doodle to honour legendary Indian actress Sridevi on her 60th birth anniversary.

Google, known for its innovative doodles, came up with captivating artwork capturing the essence of the actress in her various iconic roles. Illustrated by Mumbai-based guest artist Bhumika Mukherjee, the homage underscored the beautiful actress's deep impact on popular culture.

Known for her ravishing smile, Sridevi made Bollywood's sweeping dramas and comedies shine, oftentimes without a male counterpart in a traditionally male-dominated industry, the search engine said in its tribute.

Sridevi was born on August 13 in 1963 in present-day Tamil Nadu



and starred in over 300 movies.

As a child, she fell in love with movies and started acting as a four-year-old in the Tamil film Kandhan Karunai.

Sridevi learned to speak multiple South Indian languages, which allowed her to break into India's other film industries.

Early in her career, she acted in a variety of genres and across multiple film industries, including Tamil, Telugu, and Malayalam movies.

In 1976, Sridevi gained national recognition as the protagonist in K. Balachander's Moondru

Mudichu, and followed it up with a string of hit films like Guru and Sankaral.

Widely considered the top star of Tamil cinema at the time, Sridevi's on-screen charisma garnered attention from producers from the Hindi-speaking film industry as well.

After playing the lead role in the action comedy Himmatwala, Sridevi established herself as a national icon and box-office attraction in Bollywood.

Over the next decade, Sridevi starred in hits like the romantic drama film Sadma and the comedy ChhaalBaz, and later

switched to television where she headlined shows like Malini and Kaboom. She then joined the Asian Academy of Film & Television board of directors.

In 2012, she announced her comeback with English Vinglish; the film marked her successful return as a leading lady in Bollywood after a 12-year hiatus.

The Indian government also honoured her with the Padma Shri.

In 2017, Sridevi starred in the crime thriller Mom as a rage-filled and protective mother, earning her the National Film Award for best actress.

"Sridevi forever made her mark on the film industry by charting new avenues for women to take on leading roles in Indian cinema. She will be remembered as one of the greatest Indian actors of her time," Google said.

Syria accuses America of destabilising nation

Damascus, Aug 13: Syria on Saturday blamed the United States for the deadly attack that was carried out by the Islamic State (IS) against a Syrian military bus and resulted in the killing of at least 33 soldiers on Friday. In a statement released on Saturday night, the Syrian Foreign Ministry viewed the attack as a part of the ongoing American campaign against Syria's sovereignty and independence, accusing

the United States of supporting the IS to destabilise Syria.

The Ministry emphasised that "this aggressive action fits into the broader pattern of American escalation aimed at undermining Syria's territorial integrity and sovereignty." The ministry further noted the alarming coincidence between the attack and the continuous American exploitation of Syria's oil and agricultural resources.

Thousands protest in Israel against judicial reform

Tel Aviv, Aug 13: Tens of thousands of Israelis took to the streets of Tel Aviv on Saturday for the 32nd week of protests against Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's judicial reform.

The organizers said dozens of rallies were underway across the country, even as Netanyahu promised to scale back the controversial judicial overhaul.

The neighborhood in Tel Aviv that houses government buildings was again off-limits to traffic. The Jerusalem Post reported that three Palestinians were detained for allegedly entering Israel illegally.

Protesters threatened to paralyze the national economy if the right-wing government pressed on with its contentious plan to limit the ability of judges to overturn government decisions that they deem unreasonable. Opposition leader Yair Lapid joined the Saturday demonstration to demand that Netanyahu's government obey the law, according to his social media posting, which showed him walking with the crowd along Kaplan Street.

Beijing, Aug 13: China has expressed strong dissatisfaction over the transit of Taiwan's vice president and presidential candidate Lai Ching-te through the United States and has strongly condemned Lai's visit to the US, the Chinese Foreign Ministry said on Sunday.

Lai Ching-te said in a post on X, formerly known as Twitter, on Saturday night that he had arrived in New York, making a transit stop there on his way to Paraguay, where Lai plans to attend the inauguration of Paraguayan president-elect Santiago Pena.

"China is strongly against any form of official interaction between the US and

Taiwan, and also against Taiwanese separatists

visiting the US under any pretext or justification, and opposes any form of official contact between the US government and Taiwan. China has expressed strong dissatisfaction with the United States over the organisation of the 'transit' of Lai Ching-te and has strongly condemned it," the Chinese Foreign Ministry said in a statement.

The ministry said that, under the guise of 'transit,' the United States and Taiwan have organized an opportunity for Lai to carry out political activities in the US, which violates the one-China principle and also seriously damages

China's sovereignty and territorial integrity.

Taiwanese deputy foreign minister Yui Tah-ray said at the start of August that Lai Ching-te was going to make transit stops in New York and San Francisco on his way to and back from Paraguay.

On July 20, Taiwan's CNA news agency reported that China considered preventing Lai's transit stopovers in the US a "top priority," as "this is a very dangerous path they [Taiwan] are taking." In April, Taiwan's ruling Democratic Progressive Party officially nominated Lai, who also serves as its chairman, as its candidate for the 2024 presidential election.

Current Taiwanese president Tsai Ing-wen cannot run for the office again as she has already served two consecutive presidential terms.

Taiwan has been governed independently from mainland China since 1949. Beijing views the island as its province, while Taiwan - a territory with its own elected government - maintains that it is an autonomous country, but stops short of declaring independence. Beijing opposes any official contacts of foreign states with Taipei and considers Chinese sovereignty over the island indisputable. Taiwan currently has only a few official diplomatic allies, including Paraguay.

Infiltration bids across J&K border foiled: Police

Srinagar, Aug 13: Director General of J&K Police Dilbag Singh on Sunday said majority of infiltration bids from across the border were foiled and militants who were trying to cross this side were killed.

"This year all major encounters happened on the border during the infiltration bids from across the border. We have successfully foiled all infiltration bids and terrorists who were trying to cross this side were neutralised," DGP told media persons on the

sidelines of a "Tiranga Rally" here.

He said so far all the major infiltration bids across the border have been foiled successfully.

Replying to a question, the DGP said there is no need to count the number of militants present, "but we should keep alert continuously as Pakistan is still making all efforts to lure the young youth through social media". "I feel happy that people have realised that militancy is the way of destruction only", the DGP said. Iterating the youth have

chosen the path of peace, he congratulate them while pointing out "there are still some misled ones who need to join the mainstream to live their lives peacefully," he stated.
